#### From the Pastor's Desk

"Well, before COVID..." This has become the preamble to many of our conversations over the past 3-4 months. Feels more like a year though, doesn't it?

Do you remember saying this when things seemed to be chaotic, before COVID? "All you can do is take it a day at a time." If we said that in somewhat of a half-hearted or pithy way 'before COVID', I'm

sure we have changed our tune! Every decision that only required 2-3 outlying considerations 'before COVID' now takes 3 meetings trying to predict the unpredictable, all usually ending with someone saying, "who even knows what's gonna happen?!" As far as the calendar is concerned, everything has been marked as 'tentative.'

Strangely enough, however, I have also found a profound sense of peace in this pandemic. It is said that you don't really know what you have until it's gone, and the peace I have experienced through all of this has come from the reminder that our Lord gives us in Matthew 6, "And which of you by being anxious can add a single hour to his span of life? Therefore do not be anxious about tomorrow, for tomorrow will be anxious for itself. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble." Before COVID, before the illusion of the control we think we have was abruptly shattered, maybe those words of our Lord echoed only faintly in our minds. They have since taken on profound significance. Haven't they? These words of the Lord should remind us that we never had control to begin with, so we have lost nothing, but only gained a wonderful opportunity to experience the peace found in letting go of the control we never had and resting in what Christ has already done for us. He has made us the children of God through His blood, and so tells us, "Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." – Matt. 6:33.

Why do we say the Lord's prayer at almost every gathering together in our Church? To be reminded of what our Lord taught us when He taught us to pray, "Our Father, who art in heaven...give us this day our daily bread." What the Lord is teaching us, and what we are hearing with fresh ears yet again, is a truth we should have been putting first every day: that God has promised to give us all we need to be at peace with Him for today, and the promise of His faithfulness to provide again tomorrow; whatever tomorrow may bring. Despite all that we don't know about tomorrow, despite everything we cannot predict, and the control we don't have, we can look to every day on our future calendar and write, in permanent ink, "Jesus." He is enough, and He is always with you.

I miss all of you dearly, and keep each of you in my prayers. Don't hesitate to reach out to me if I can minister to you in any way--even at a distance.


