FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Greetings St. Mark!

Greetings in the name of our Lord, Jesus Christ!

"Therefore, <u>since</u> we <u>are</u> surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God." – Hebrews 12:1-2

When you arrive at St. Mark Lutheran Church and walk through the front doors, into the new gathering space to grab your coffee, and into our beautiful and newly refurbished sanctuary, you are walking through a cloud of witnesses. When you sit in the fellowship hall for Bible study, drop your kids off at one of our classrooms for Sunday school, or enjoy our gym and playground during one of our many events throughout the year, you do so because of a cloud of faithful witnesses who came before us. That is too easily forgotten, and we must be intentional about remembering.

The church you know and love as St. Mark is here because faithful Christians like you followed our Lord's call to be good stewards with the blessings He provided, to sacrifice earthly

gain for the sake of His eternal kingdom, and to be generous for the sake of generations they would never meet – at least on earth. It's so important we remember what God has so graciously given us through His faithful saints of the past so that we ourselves are able to walk faithfully after our Lord and have His will fulfilled among us, which will be the fulfillment and satisfaction our hearts and souls long for. The sober realization that we are all beneficiaries of the generosity of generations before us is what will help us endure in our generosity to generations after us. I know you see as clearly as I do how desperately our younger generations are not only going to need to benefit from our faithfulness to Christ, but our generosity that will propel the Gospel forward.

We hear a lot about "changing the world", especially as we enter another election year. As those whom Christ has called to Himself, you and I know that there is only one hope for this world: the truth of Jesus Christ and the proclamation of His Gospel. This starts in our own homes, in our own church, and in our own ministry together.

As the author of Hebrews said above, it was for the joy set before Him that Christ endured the cross. Jesus found joy in the sacrifice of the cross because His eyes were focused beyond the sacrifice, to the Father, to His will, and to His love for you and me. This joyous and sacrificial Lord has promised us the same. We will find eternal joy in sacrifice, and many times only in sacrifice, because it forces our eyes off ourselves and onto Jesus who is the "founder and perfector of our faith", to the eternal inheritance we have already received in His blood that has paid our debt of death to God, and to His resurrection that gives us the riches of His presence in heaven forever.

This weekend, September 16th and 17th, we are launching our <u>Generous 2 Generations</u> campaign, and I pray it is a campaign you will walk through with me over the next three years. The cloud of witnesses before us have helped to make our campaign goals very manageable and easily attainable with our eyes fixed on Jesus.

I ask you to prayerfully, seriously, and intentionally consider how you will come to know the joy that the Lord has set before us at St. Mark, in the blessed ministry we have together, and in the eternal satisfaction of faithful sacrifice for the sake of our Lord Jesus, His glory, and His kingdom.




